**Simon Murray** has 40 years of leadership experience in education. He is past Headmaster of St Peter's College, Adelaide; Canberra Grammar School and Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School. In all he has twenty seven years of Headmaster experience. Simon was elected Chair of Association of Heads of Independent Schools of Australia from 2009–2011, representing over 390 member schools. He is a past Board member of the Independent Schools Council of Australia. He was appointed a Fellow of the Australian College of Educators in 2008 for his leadership in the independent school sector. In 2017 he was appointed a Fellow of the Australian Council for Educational Leaders. He has presented at national and international conferences on wellbeing, leadership, cultural change, and future directions in education. He was the St Peter's College representative for Dr. Seligman's role as Adelaide's Thinker in Residence – Department of the Premier and Cabinet. He is the foundation Chairman and a Board member of the Positive Education Schools Association (PESA) in Australia and a member of the steering committee of the International Positive Education Network (IPEN).

Simon co-edited the book *Evidence-based Approaches to Positive Education in Schools* published by Springer in 2015. His second co-edited book, *Future Directions in Wellbeing: Education: Organisation and Policy* has just been released.
