Peggy received a BA in Psychology from Arizona State University, a Masters and PhD in social/personality psychology from the University of California, Riverside, and received additional postdoctoral training at the University of Pennsylvania.

Her research draws on multiple fields of inquiry, including health, positive, social, personality, and developmental psychology, and public health to address the question of thriving across the lifespan. She incorporates a lifespan perspective, innovative methodologies and interdisciplinary collaboration. Peggy has published over 80 articles and chapters and two books, and actively works to bridge gaps between research and practice. She has delivered presentations around the world and developed several wellbeing measures.
