What is an Inter Year Carer (IYC)?

 Year 11 student responsible for supporting and mentoring a small group of year 7 students with the transition from primary

to secondary school





What does the role of the IYC involve?

- Building positive relationships rapport and trust
- Assisting year 7s with organisation, time management and monitoring how they are managing socially and emotionally
- Liaising with key staff involved in supporting year 7s
- Aim is to support the wellbeing of year 7s and foster resilience and independence



How is the IYC Program organised?

- IYCs selected in term 4 of Year 10 following an application and interview process
- Year 11 leadership position
- 1 IYC per vertical Form Class, 8 per House
- Each IYC supports 4 or 5 year 7s in the same Form Class
- IYC Training Day
- Mentored by Head of House weekly meetings
